- Developed a specimen request system, streamlined the specimen collection and transport process, and standardized operating procedures. Facilitated rise in collected specimens from 96 in 2018 to 563 in 2019 (586% increase).
- Independently created and maintained the Cure CF Columbus website ([www.CureCFColumbus.org](http://www.CureCFColumbus.org)) to disseminate information to the members of the Cure CF Columbus research community comprised of Nationwide Children's Hospital and The Ohio State University investigators.
- Formulated database design and collaborated with the Data Collaboration Team to build custom reports capable of compiling data stored across various data centers (Epic, REDCap, STARS).
- Successfully obtained grant funding in 2019 worth roughly \$300,000 over a four-year period.

### ***Research Data Analyst, Pediatric Pulmonary Medicine***

***Jul 2017 – Present***

- Designed, developed, and implemented information management platforms using Smartsheet. Centralized regulatory monitoring of clinical trials while eliminated the need for 35+ tracking spreadsheets. Tracking improvements revealed unbilled invoiceable events in 2018 and 2019. Led to the recovery of over \$40,000.
- Assumed responsibility for maintaining and monitoring performance metrics that impact annual funding provided by the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. Recovered nearly \$7,000 by identifying and correcting errors found on previous reports. Improved national ranking from 15<sup>th</sup> in 2017 to 3<sup>rd</sup> in 2019 for total number of weighted subject units, which resulted in an 85% increase in awarded funds (roughly \$36,000).
- Provided data support to 65+ retrospective and prospective IRB research studies. Co-authored four peer-reviewed journal articles, 24 abstracts, and 16 poster presentations between 2016 and 2019.
- Actively participated in the hiring process of Pulmonary Research Core employees. Mentored and trained new employees on hospital programs and software.

- Designed, developed, deployed, and maintained projects in REDCap. Led initiative to collect questionnaire responses electronically using iPads and survey feature within REDCap.
- Facilitated requests for biostatistics services. Standardized the process for requesting statistical support. Identified cost benefits of establishing a service agreement, which reduced hourly cost by over 50% (\$30,000+ annually).
- Evaluated various tracking processes. Redesigned spreadsheets to assist with monitoring trends, identifying errors, and disseminating information from large datasets.
